

Sonia Kafoussi is a Professor in Didactics of Mathematics, at the Department of Sciences of Preschool Education and Educational Design of the University of the Aegean in Greece. She is a graduate of the Mathematics Department of the National and Kapodistrian University of Athens (1990) and she received her PhD from the Department of Pedagogy and Primary Education of the National and Kapodistrian University of Athens, titled: "Students' errors in Mathematics and their role in the training of primary school teachers" (1995). Since 2007 she is an elected member of the International Commission for the Study and Improvement of Mathematics Education (CIEAEM). She has a large number of publications in international and Greek journals and conferences and collective volumes. She is the co-author of the books "Mathematics of 4-6 year old children. Numbers and space" (2008, Pataki Publications Athens, Greece) and "School class, family, society and mathematical education" (2013, Pataki Publications, Athens, Greece). She is a member of the editorial team of the book "Educational Paths to Mathematics: A C.I.E.A.E.M. Sourcebook" (U. Gellert, J. Rodriguez Gimenez, C. Hahn, & S. Kafoussi (Eds.), 2015, Springer's Advances in Mathematics Education Series). Her research interests focus mainly on the development of children's mathematical thinking in early childhood and the role of parental involvement in mathematics education.
